


Design the library's next card!








### Submissions due June 30, 2024


## Library Card Art Contest

#### **Rules and Waiver**

- Use the entry form to create a library card design.
- Submissions may be in any two-dimensional art medium (illustration, pen, paint, crayons, digital, photography, etc.).
- Use the entire space (up to the outer bleed line) on the entry form for your design. Please note that a portion of the design will be cut off around the outside during production up to the final cut lines, represented on the entry form by the arrows.
- Only vertical designs will be considered.
- Limit one (1) entry per person.



- Original artwork only. Designs containing copyright restrictions (popular characters, logos, images, etc.) will not be considered.
- Submitted artwork will not be returned.
- The winning artist must be a Livermore resident.
