
PURPOSE


For someone experiencing homelessness, keeping yourself and your clothes clean can be incredibly challenging, and can greatly impact your ability to get and keep a job, or simply participate in society. To meet this need, the City of Fremont, City of Newark, and several community partners developed the Clean Start Mobile Hygiene Program to provided muchneeded shower and laundry services to our homeless neighbors.

- City of Fremont and City of Newark decide to use funds for Mobile Hygiene Unit




Infrastructure Upgrades

- New black/grey water clean-out at City Corporation Yard
- City Environmental Services worked with Union Sanitary District to complete a sewer cleanout assessment of all possible sites
- Reached out to Elks Lodge for alternate clean-out sites

- Existing providers have gained a lot of valuable experience
- Tie showers to existing homeless services
- Explore Solar power option & Shower Timers
