Bay Area Community Health (BACH) SUD/MAT Services for Individuals Who Are Unhoused

- History of successful partnership with Abode to provide services to vulnerable populations in Livermore
- Funding from Alameda County and also the City of Livermore has supported mobile health and street health initiatives
- Partnerships with local city and county agencies have supported and enhanced the effectiveness of teams that have been deployed in the community to provide services
 - ▶ Abode for social services and housing navigation
 - ► Ashbury Church Shower Program
 - ▶ City Serve and COVID Safer Ground Hotel



How Has BACH Helped Unhoused Individuals?

- Mobile services
 - Medical Assistant and Nurse practitioner provided medical care on mobile clinics-health screenings and medical interventions for those with acute needs
- ► Homeless Street Medicine
 - When possible the BACH team did outreach with Abode staff, and targeted their efforts towards individuals with high needs
 - Telehealth appointments were conducted with those who needed support at times when outreach providers were not in the field
 - Providers and medical support staff were also able to order labs, do screenings, and address chronic health conditions



SUD Support for Individuals In Encampments

- Utilize Homeless Street Health (HSM)Model (launching 11/2020)
 - Subcontract with Abode Services to provide an 1.0 FTE RN and .3 FTE medical provider
 - Send a provider who is x-waivered and able to prescribe medications (MAT) to assist with treating problematic substance use
 - ▶ Partner with local pharmacy so clients can access it to fill prescriptions
 - ▶ Refer clients to BACH's mobile unit for MAT treatment
 - Assign a substance abuse counselor to go out with HSM team and/or mobile clinic team for low intensity counseling and care coordination and linkage to tele-health appointments with substance use treatment services
 - ▶ Partner with Axis Health Center to refer patients with primary care, behavioral health, substance use treatment needs
 - Social Worker from Abode can assist clients with getting assigned to a medical home, on Medi-Cal, document ready for housing support services, and linked to any other necessary social services
 - Possible inclusion of harm reduction support with HSM and/or mobile teams
