




CONCEPT 1: Flag Allée Livermore, CA.

CONCEPT 1: Flag Allée

Flag Allée creates a patriotic gateway that encourages visitors to reflect and remember. Flag poles stationed around the oval entry lawn memorialize Livermore's veterans before opening into the wider central lawn, perfect for larger memorial events and community gatherings.

Just bellow the entry lawn, a trellised picnic area shades visitors while the train-yard inspired playground engages the children of Livermore with their town's history, providing a play amenity that centers the site within its cultural context.

CONCEPT 2: Flagpole Plaza

Flagpole Plaza creates a flexible event space that can cater to formal memorials or everyday use. Flags of the armed forces are massed at the heart of the site, memorializing Livermore's veterans in a central plaza. A specimen tree shades the plaza while lawn buffers the plaza from the playground to the South.

As the avenue arcs along the large, central lawn, a giant accent oak tree catches visitors' eyes and creates a serene sense of place that encourages passers-by to pause for a quite respite.

CONCEPT 3: Central Lawn

Central Lawn creates multiple protected and comfortable community gathering space while providing a direct, pleasant connection to neighboring destinations. Flags of the armed forces are set in the upper plaza, serving as the site's thematic focal point under the shade of the large trellises.

The circular turf lawn creates a central gathering

space as people pass through the park, while buffering the upper plaza from the "Early Livermore" inspired playground.

Visitors are drawn through the site thanks to the strong connection created by the grand central lawn, while benches and shade trees create comfortable nodes.
