Meet your community.

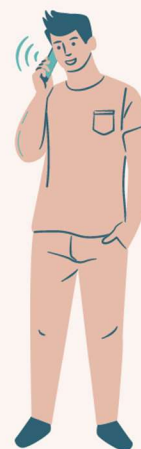
When facing landlord harassment or eviction, it's powerful to unionize. Meet local organizations and neighbors to build community power.
